2021-2022 A-F Letter Grades Released

At the direction of the State Board of Education, the Arizona Department of Education released the 2021-2022 school letter grades after a two year letter grade hiatus.

Letter grades are based on academic growth from year to year, scores on the statewide assessment, high school graduation rates and quantitative indicators showing a student is accelerating and ready for success at the next level.

Schools have until November 15th at 5:00 PM to appeal their letter grade. Schools who appeal their letter grade will be marked as "UR" (under review) until the State Board of Education takes action on their appeal at the December 9, 2022 meeting. Depending on the outcome of appeals, schools' letter grades may change.

The breakdown of the 2021-2022 letter grades by school type, prior to any appeal submission:
